The Interventional Radiology Society of Australasia executive and Annual Scientific Meeting organising committee, would like to invite submission of abstracts from Registrar/IR Fellows, on original work, for consideration at the IRSA Annual Scientific meeting taking place in Uluru from the 9th – 11th July 2019.

The prize is jointly offered by IRSA and CIRSE and includes a return economy flight to the CIRSE annual scientific meeting in 2019 (Barcelona, Spain) or 2020 (Munich, Germany), hotel accommodation and free registration to the CIRSE 2019 or 2020 meeting.

Submission of abstracts for consideration of the prize should be made to the IRSA secretariat Ms Hilary Baldwin before May 20th 2019 hilary.baldwin@ranzcr.edu.au

Only shortlisted presentations will be invited for presentation at the annual scientific meeting. Applicants are expected to be informed of the acceptance results by June 3rd 2019.

Please read the following terms and conditions carefully before preparing your abstract:

Terms and conditions

1. Eligible applicants are accredited RANZCR radiology registrars or IR fellows/advanced trainees residing in Australia and New Zealand. Applicants must still be a registrar or IR fellow/advanced trainee at the time of the presentation at the IRSA annual scientific meeting July 9th 2019 (if accepted).
2. Abstracts must not exceed 400 words. (The limit applies to the main body of the abstract only and excludes the abstract title, authors, affiliations and references).
3. The abstract title should be short and informative. Key words should be listed below the main body of the abstract.
4. All presenting authors must include a one-page summary CV.
5. Short listing of submissions will be made by members of the IRSA executive. Applications from applicants across all RANZCR branches are encouraged.
6. Judging will be conducted at the ASM by two judges appointed by IRSA. The judges' decision will be final.
7. The winner of the prize will be expected to attend the Gala Dinner at the IRSA ASM in order to receive the prize.
8. The prize must be taken in 2019 or 2020 (ie the winner will be expected to attend CIRSE 2019 or CIRSE 2020)
9. The prize is non-transferrable and may not be taken in cash value.

10. Travel and accommodation arrangements will be made by IRSA and CIRSE; there will be no reimbursement or part-payment for travel or accommodation arrangements made by the winner.
11. The prize does not cover visa costs, meals, travel insurance, transportation (other than a return economy flight) and other incidental costs.
12. If none of the submitted abstracts achieve the required standard, the prize may not be awarded.
